Wraparound Services at Lynn Center

What are Wraparound Services? Wraparound services provide intensive support for families of young children with complex needs such as developmental delays, severe behavioral and/or emotional difficulties, and mental health needs.

How It Works: A team is composed of family, friends, and professionals involved in the child's life. The team sets goals chosen by the family and develops an action plan, plus strategies, to achieve the goals, and identifies who is responsible for each task. We evaluate our progress each time we meet, and update the plan as necessary.



What We Do: The Wraparound team identifies the family's strengths and sets goals to meet the family's needs. We offer the services of licensed clinical social workers, therapists, mental health teachers and workers, family partners, and a team facilitator. With a positive approach of sharing and cooperation, team members meet regularly for six months to one year. The team works with the family to minimize and resolve problems and achieve goals that are important to family members for a more stable and balanced family life. Working together, we help to prevent problems later in life.

About Us: The Wraparound program at Lynn Center has been providing early intervention services to children and their families in Contra Costa County since 2003. We provide services that are family focused, strength-based, and especially designed to help parents develop individualized plans to meet their immediate needs. Our services are available at no cost for children who have Medi-Cal insurance or who qualify for First 5 funding.

Who We Serve: The Wraparound program serves families with young children from birth to six years of age with very complex needs.

Wraparound Services:

One of the Contra Costa ARC family of programs.

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Eligibility:

- Child and family live in Contra Costa County.
- Child has Medi-Cal health coverage or qualifies for First 5 funding.
- Child's insurance does not cover mental health services.
- Parents are committed to participate in the team process.
- Child is involved with at least two systems of care such as mental health, public health, education, etc.
